**\$2,500 Annual Scholarship**

This scholarship was established in memory of Daneen S. Barbour, Barbour Concrete Company, and 1994 recipient of the National Precast Concrete Association prestigious Robert E. Yoakum Award of Merit. Daneen was a proponent of higher education for everyone, including industry leaders, through post-graduate work, and advanced degrees in areas that complement the precast concrete industry.

Daneen enjoyed learning and always encouraged everyone around her to expand his or her education at every opportunity. After raising a family, Daneen earned her Masters degree. She contributed to the family business by developing valuable training programs for all employees and in many other areas of the company. She valued the discipline required to achieve an advanced degree, was a strong advocate of post-graduate studies, and also recognized the importance of non-classroom forms of education.

## CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION TO RECEIVE THIS SCHOLARSHIP

Applicants must:

1. Be enrolled or have a written Plan of Study in a post-graduate degree of benefit to the precast industry.
2. Be taking a minimum of six hours per semester towards the chosen degree.
3. Maintain a 3.5 (4.0) or better GPA.
4. Meet all standing criteria of the NPCA Scholarship program.

## RESTRICTIONS

1. An annual scholarship up to \$2500 will be awarded to an individual who has earned an undergraduate degree.
2. Applicants with a Plan of Study, or already enrolled in Middle Tennessee State University's or Chico State University's Concrete Industry Management program (or similar programs "endorsed" by the National Precast Concrete Association) will be given first consideration. In the event there are no applicants meeting the primary scholarship criteria, consideration will be given to graduate student applicants who are employed by a company that serves the precast concrete industry.
3. Applicants must apply, or reapply, annually.
4. No individual will be eligible to receive the scholarship more than two consecutive years.
5. This scholarship will be awarded only for advanced course work in which the individual is currently enrolled or enrolling for a future course. It does not apply for courses already completed.
